DIBELS – The expectation is that 80% of students will make typical or better growth by the end of the year. Growth is for each student no matter where they currently are.

Middle of the Year Growth:

Kindergarten – 66% 1st Grade – 84% 2nd Grade – 57% 3rd Grade – 58% 4th Grade 51% 5th Grade – 80%

At SEP's the teachers will let parents know what growth their student has made. Dibels helps find "holes" in a student's reading and being able to fill them in.

What are we doing to increase growth:

*Additional para (smaller groups), more targeted comprehension interventions lessons (purchasing materials), intervention coaching, adding small group Tier 1 instructions where needed.

*Interventions reading and now math in a few classes. Next year both Math and reading will be back into school day.

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*95% Group -comprehensive kit to help groups grow – purchasing a few of these now. Hope to have one per class soon.

Other items:

*Title 1 Status – we will be Title 1 next year. We are #10 of 11 schools designated as Title 1 schools. Title 1 lets us fund paras for small groups.

*Trustlands Amendment: Use the surplus and maybe a little technology money to hire a 12 hour para in the afternoon to make 3rd grade and kindergarten groups smaller. They would also be trained to do progress monitoring. Hours for para are Monday – Thursdays from 12:30 to 3:30.

Heritage Days in September.

Would love to see Red Mountain represented in performances such as art or choir or both.

There is also a parade we could enter.

Young Dr's: Dr Whitehead and Dr. Park started the program. It is improving every year. It is possible to do a second session if enough students are interested.
