Trustland Amendment: Jenny Leavitt

We have too much money in our Trust Land Funds and we need to spend some.

The amendment would ask to use the funds for a high ability aide and new technology for our school. The technology would be for buying new computers for teachers and new projectors.

All the teacher's laptops were purchased the same year and they are starting to wear out. We would replace 5 with Trustland funds and 4 or 5 with school funds. This would replace about half of them. We would then purchase 4 or 5 new projectors to replace some of those that are wearing out. This way we can replace old items slowly and not have to do it all at once.

The Council approved and signed the amendment. Jenny will submit it to the School Board for approval.
