Jenny Leavitt went over the Tentative Plan for 2022-2023

The Data we will use for the goals will not be ready until the first of next year but we have to put a plan together now for next year.

• Reading

Retain, hire and train paras and a reading intervention teacher (Mrs. Perez) **Acadience Reading Data** (DIBELS) – measure growth

• Math

Retain, hire, and train paras We are adding math to our plan so we can use the paras for both reading and math interventions.

Acadience Math Data – measure growth. We will look at individual students but have an overall growth % for the entire group.

• Partially fund a classroom teacher to keep class sizes smaller

Everyone ok'd the tentative plan. Jenny will email all council members when the plan is complete and signatures are required – either electronically or in person.

All students will receive help with paras 30 minutes a week in a group.

There will be no platooning next year. We have found our students do better without platooning. Jenny has articles on pros & cons on platooning if anyone is interested.

We will still have **all day Kindergarten next year**. Parents can still choose ½ day as well.

We will need a new Music Para for next year—12 hours per week. It could be more hours if they are willing to do other para jobs.

Reading:

We are seeing improvement in our students with the new reading program. Teachers are being trained in this. It is a 2-year program. Teachers K-3 have all agreed to do the training. Jenny has arranged to pay a stipend to the teachers who complete the training. Jenny has worked out time during the week for teachers to learn and complete assignments on this training while at school.

Can teachers serve on Community Council?

Jenny is not sure. She will check on it.

What we do know is we have to have more parents than employees. The Council would like to have input from teachers.
