2022 - 2023 School Improvement Plan Update

- Reading
 - Retained, hired and trained paras We have filled all but one of our intervention para positions. Mrs. Perez is providing Tier 3 reading interventions for 1st and 2nd grade.
 - DIBELS MOY GROWTH (The state goal is 60% and the district goal is 75%.)
 - READING MOY GROWTH
 - Kindergarten 72% District Title 1 79%
 - 1st grade 50% District Title 1 51%
 - 2nd grade 35% District Title 1 53%

What can we do to help this group?

- Mrs. Perez has been working with 2nd graders
- Next year we will have Mrs. Perez with will these 2nd Graders in 3rd grade.
- We will keep watching and working with these 2nd graders.
- 2nd Grade has moved math to the morning to see if it makes an impact.
- Mrs. Dixon is reaching out to some of the parents to help students with reading to help with fluency.
- Community Council members were asked to promote SEP's so teachers can talk to parents.
- RTI helps higher kids grow (in reading).
- We have asked for a portable. Wellness room was good. We now have a calming corner in Mrs. Shankula's room.
- The 2nd graders are a tricky group. They are not very independent learners. We feel they are moving in the right direction.
 - 3rd grade 48% District Title 1 55%
 - 4th grade 52% District Title 1 61%
 - 5th grade 67% District Title 1 63%
 - Since MOY 78% of 1st graders have made progress or maintained in accuracy.
 - Since MOY 76% of 2nd graders have made progress or maintained in accuracy.
 - Bi-weekly intervention team meetings to discuss struggling students and plan and track interventions.
 - Frequent progress monitoring and quarterly data meetings.
 - Take home library is being updated to align with the science of reading.

• Positive Student Behavior

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- Schoolwide management plan
 - Mini Hawk tickets and Principal's 200 Club
 - Skills Room and Behavior Tech
 - Counselor services and presentations, Second Step program
 - New counselor next year. Will fund them to work on Fridays as
 - well. School counselors can only meet with a student 6 times in 1 year.
- Looking at adding a restorative practice para. This Para would be trained to do behavior plans and manage Tier 3 kids behavior. This would take a load off the Principal and Mr. Dixon. The para would also pick up surplus from the counselor to help with behavior groups.
- Community Council would like to see Watch Dogs back. Dallas is working on details for a new Watch Dog program.

Next Steps:

- K-2
 - **30 minutes a day of whole group UFLI instruction (University of Florida Institute)** Teachers are really excited about this program and the kids love it.
 - o 30-60 minutes a day of daily small group differentiated instruction
 - 30 minutes of whole group grade level text with imbedded fluency, vocabulary, grammar & comprehension strategies
- 3-5
 - \circ 30-60 minutes a day of daily small group differentiated instruction
 - 30 minutes whole group grade level text with imbedded vocabulary and grammar as well as targeted set purpose
 - Increased time and focus on reading throughout the day
 - RISE benchmark modules
