## **2022-2023 School Improvement Plan Update**

- **Reading**

- Retained, hired and trained paras – We will be short 3 intervention paras after the winter break and 1 special education para. Mrs. Perez is providing Tier 3 reading interventions for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
- DIBLES MOY GROWTH (The state goal is 60% and the district goal is 75%). This is preliminary data.
- Bi-weekly intervention team meetings to discuss struggling students and plan and track interventions.
- Frequent progress monitoring and quarterly data meetings.
- Take home library is being updated to align with the science of reading.
- We pay 1 extra teacher from these funds to keep our classes small.

- **Math**

- I will have updated data for this at our next meeting.

- **Positive Student Behavior**

- Schoolwide management plan
  - Mini Hawk Tickets and Principal's 200 Club.
  - Skills Room and Behavior Tech – Help kids take missed tests. This is a tool for kids. Part of the plan. Google doc to track those using a wellness pass. We can track those using wellness room and look for patterns. Notice who is struggling and what times they are struggling: during recess, math, etc. Keeping kids on task. Behavior tech with kids all the time.

## **Next Steps:**

- Strengthen and align small reading group instruction.
- Kindergarten: Distributive practice of phonemic awareness and letters/sounds, blending routines

- 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grades: Strengthen Tier 1 and align with grade level text (in addition to decodables)
- 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> Grades: Close reading and DAZE practice
- Marilyn – Teaches classes here.
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- **Preliminary DIBLES MOY GROWTH (testing isn't complete.)**
  - Kindergarten Last year MOY 58% This year MOY 76% Last year district 73%
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Last year MOY 46% This year MOY 50% Last year district 62%
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Last year MOY 47% This year MOY 35% Last year district 57%
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Last year MOY 53% This year MOY 50% Last year district 63%
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Last year MOY 43% This year MOY 45% Last year district 62%
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Last year MOY 47% This year MOY 61% Last year district 63%
