School Plan for 2024 - 2025: Jenny Leavitt

- 80% of students will make typical or better growth in reading and math from BOY to EOY.
 - Acadience math (Illustrative math) and reading benchmarks will be used to measure student growth.
 - Strengthen Tier 1 whole group instruction, small group instruction and intervention instruction through professional development using the new reading curriculum.
 - Hire and retain paras to provide targeted intervention and extensions during WIN time. Continue to train paras to work with students during WIN time.
 - Retain a para to manage a take home library so students have access to books for learning at home.
 - Hire and retain paras to help in kindergarten classrooms
 - Help fund an additional teacher to reduce class sizes and reduce reading group and intervention group sizes. (Fund 1.4 teachers from these monies).
 - Hire and retain a skills room para and a behavior tech.

Title 1 Status and Updates: Dallas Dixon

Dallas reported that we are in danger of losing our Title I status. Last year we were at 58%. This year we are at 54.8%. The state lets the District decide which schools get the money.

Other items:

Lindsey Chandler asked why we still have wood chips in our playground area and not the rubber. Jenny Leavitt explained that she has asked for it for the last 4 years from the District. There are only 2

Elementary schools without it. Jenny asked the concerned parents to email Michael Lee at the District Office asking for the rubber to be installed.

Parents asked about our head custodian Jeff Wittwer and if he is really retiring? Jenny Leavitt said yes. Parents voiced their appreciation for Jeff and will be sad to see him go.

Teacher situation for Mrs. Johnsen's 3rd Grade Class. Mrs. Johnsen is currently out because of health reasons. Mrs. Carlson has been teaching since the first of the year. Mrs. Carlson has family obligations and will not be able to stay any longer. Mrs. Byers-Stewart will be taking over the class after Fall Break until Mrs. Johnsen returns (hopefully in November).

Genna Goodwin said she would like to see the grades of these students as they have had different teachers this year and they also had co-teachers when they were in Kindergarten.

Lindsey Chandler asked about our safe routes plan. Dallas Dixon informed everyone that our plan has been submitted to the District and was just approved and is now online for all to view.

Gaga Ball Pit has been added to give the upper grades something to do during recess. The kids really love it.
