  - 2 trained "Guardians" (concealed carry) who receive training.
  - RMES has 2 guardians whose identities cannot be disclosed.

- RMES is getting indoor and outdoor cameras (hallways and front and back of school)
- Fire drills every other month

- Teachers all have gate key
